Short bio-data of the Nominee (max 500 words):

Senaka Obtained a Diploma in Data Processing Management from Institute of Data Processing Management, UK in the early 1980s. Subsequently, Senaka obtained a Graduate Diploma in Business Administration from Singapore Institute of Management (now known as Uni-SIM). He is a PMP since 2003.

Started his career as a Management Trainee with Unilever (Sri Lanka) and switched to IT soon after. At the end of 9 years, rose to Business System Analyst before deciding to move to Singapore.

In Singapore over the past 25 years, he has worked for EDS close to 10 years and Oracle Corporation for the next 15 years. Has performed multiple roles in Project Management disciplines over the past 20 years and was heading the PMO for ASEAN region when he was approached by DHL Supply Chain to head the IT Project Delivery for APMEA (Asia Pacific, Middle East and Africa region).

Since February, 2013, Senaka is working for DHL Supply Chain as a Senior Director, heading the IT Project Delivery.

Apart from professional work, he is also very active in social circles for a long time. Senaka was the President of the Singapore Sinhala Association, a social group looking after the interest of people of Sri Lankan origin living in Singapore.
